

**Ann Arbor OA Intergroup
GUIDELINES FOR INTERGROUP REPRESENTATIVES**

Statement of Purpose

Intergroup Representatives volunteers form the Ann Arbor Intergroup (IG). Participation is the key to harmony, and Group Representatives ensure that the activities of the IG are aligned with the groups' needs and wants. Also, the Intergroup is self-supporting through the efforts of its groups through these representatives.

Guidelines:

All groups in the A2OA Area are encouraged to part of service at the intergroup level. These people serve as a bridge between A2OA IG and its member groups.

Each group determines who their Intergroup Rep is by whatever means they choose.

Criteria: Member of a group in the A2OA Intergroup area and designated by that group to be their representative.

Responsibilities:

1. Many people from one group may participate in Intergroup, but only one of them may vote on behalf of the group. See "Voting Guidelines" for further details.
2. One person can vote on behalf of only one group.
3. Attend IG meetings regularly.
4. Relay information to and from IG and any groups they attend.
5. Inform IG if they cannot attend an IG meeting.
6. Support IG activities through service positions and committee participation.
